

Self operated equipment

• Engineers to maintain a two metre safe distance with anyone returning a vehicle

· When the work is completed the Operator will wash or sanitise their hands

· Machines thoroughly disinfected before and after every hire

• Paperless contract - no touch signature

· No touch paperless daily work sheets used

· Single use nitrile single use gloves worn

- All Engineers to use nitrile single use gloves when working on MEWPs
- · Before and after every hire, vehicles will be sanitised using Quill Supernova solution
- All 'touchpoints' will be sanitised using Quill Supernova solution
- · Machine cleaning and sanitisation to be recorded
- All employees will regularly wash hands
- If suspected of contact with COVID-19, the vehicle will be guarantined for 72 hours




Equipment cleaning and maintenance

- Returned machines will be steam cleaned before processing for post hire inspection
- · All controls will be sanitised using Quill Supernova solution
- · Machine sanitisation will be recorded in machine notes
- All employees will regularly wash hands

COVID-19 SecurePrinciples of safe operation





Remove the hazard

- · Daily briefings and updates
- · Arrange task to be conducted by one individual
- · Consider approved material handling equipment to reduce worker interface

REDUCE



Reduce the hazard by implementing planned measures

- · Maintain social distancing
- · Regularly wash hands and common touch surfaces
- · Increase ventilation in enclosed areas

ISOLATE



Ensure proactive separation

- · Retain groups that MUST work together as a stable team
- · Do not swap team members around
- · Teams should be small and separated

CONTROL



Manage and oversee work areas

- · Limited team exposure to 15 minutes
- · Introduce permit process
- · Provide additional supervision and monitoring

PPE



Protect personnel with correct equipment

- · Respirators should never be shared
- · Dispose of single use PPE appropriately
- Select appropriate PPE level for the risk
