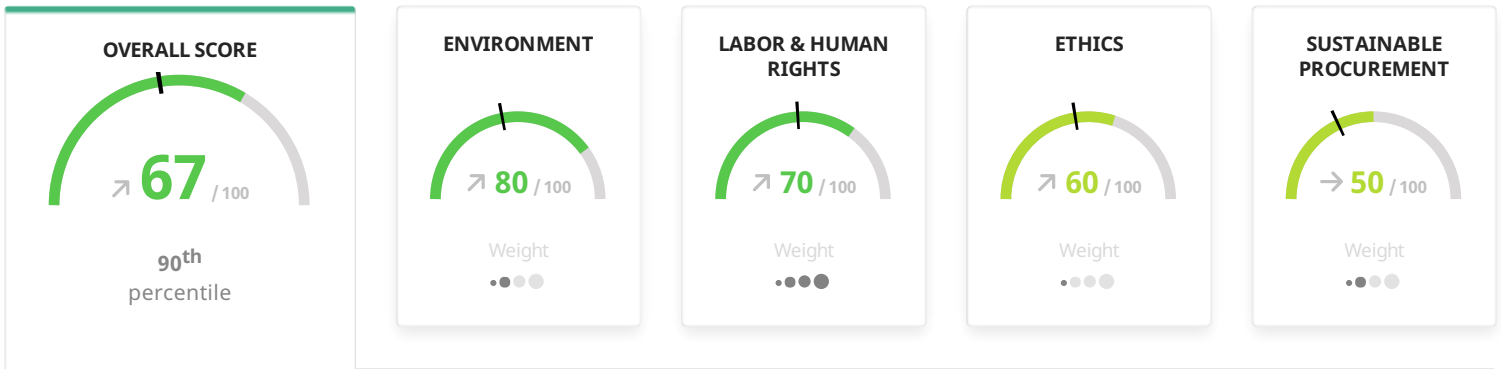


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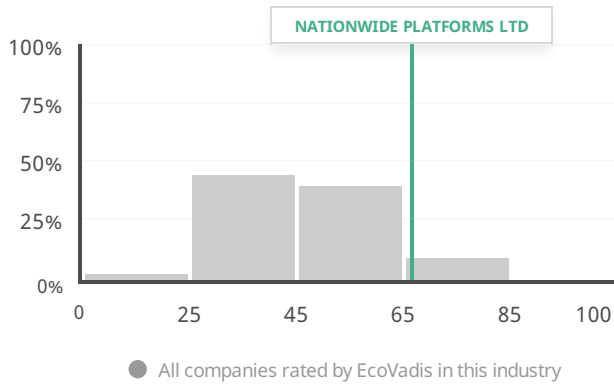

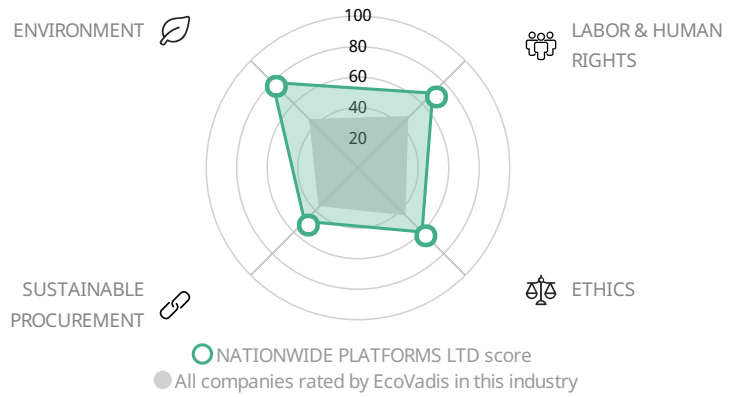

An inquest into Lee Benham's death heard that the 45-year-old was an experienced HGV driver for Nationwide Platforms Ltd having worked at the company's depot in Liskeard for close to six years. As part of his job, the father of two daughters had to load and unload and deliver scissor lift platforms, which are three-tonne raising platforms that can go up to 14 metres high and are often used on construction sites. Loxam signe le premier "prêt vert" de la BEI

La signature du prêt a eu lieu le 26 septembre à l'agence Loxam de Colombes. Afin de répondre aux enjeux de la transition énergétique, Loxam s'est engagé, d'ici 2030, à réduire de moitié les émissions directes de ses agences et de ses véhicules et de 30 % ses émissions indirectes, majoritairement liées à son parc locatif de matériel. Dans le cadre de son plan d'investissement vert pluriannuel, le loueur engage des investissements en faveur de matériels innovants sur le plan énergétique. Ainsi, l'année dernière, le Groupe a ainsi consacré pas moins de 95 millions d'euros, sur un budget d'investissement global de 400 millions d'euros, pour avancer vers cet objectif. Ce plan d'action ne repose pas uniquement sur ces investissements dans le parc de matériels (650 000 références) et dans la flotte de véhicules (400 PL en France).
